

St. Clare is Open for Public Masses and Confessions

We are aware that a portion of our parishioners are still under stay-at-home orders.

Archbishop Hartmayer has extended dispensation thru August 1, 2020.

He has suggested that people attend one Mass per week (either weekend or weekday) in order to allow everyone who wants the opportunity to attend Mass in person.

Confessions will be available on Saturdays, 3:00-4:00 pm

Confessions will be held in the Conference Room next to the Day Chapel.

Please wear a mask and maintain Social Distancing while waiting in the Narthex.

Mass Schedule

Masses are in English unless otherwise noted.

Monday – Thursday, 9:00 am	In-person and streaming
Saturday, 4:30 pm Sunday, 10:30am, 12:30 pm Spanish	In-person and streaming NOTE 12:30 pm TIME CHANGE for Spanish Mass (this is temporary to allow for proper cleaning between Masses)
Sunday, 8:00 am	In-person only (can watch the 4:30 pm streamed Mass if in parking lot overflow)

How to Attend Mass

No reservation is required, but you MUST follow these guidelines:

- **Please arrive 30 minutes before Mass** to facilitate seating
- **Check your temperature** before leaving home (if above 99.7, please do not come to Mass)
- **Please use a restroom prior to arriving**, we will only have a single bathroom open
- **Bring your own mask and hand sanitizer** – *everyone needs to wear a mask*; the Archdiocese has said that children over the age of reason (seven and older) will be expected to wear a mask, but we recommend all in attendance have some type of covering over their mouth & nose
- **Seating** - Ushers will direct you, please sit where you are told to maximize capacity
- **If you kneel during Mass**, please take care to only touch your chair and not others around you. You may also choose to remain standing if you are more comfortable.
- **Communion Distribution** will be during Mass to everyone present (including all overflow). Please follow direction of ushers and be reverent in the presence of Christ. If you choose to receive on the tongue, as is your right, please stand still.
