

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES



CASEWORKER

Caseworkers, once trained, partner with another SVDP volunteer to meet with individuals in need, assess the situation and authorize financial assistance. Due to COVID, meetings are taking place telephonically.

TIME COMMITMENT: 4-8 hours per month

THRIFT STORE

Volunteers who work at the Thrift store accept & sort items, price & display merchandise and serve customers. Most volunteers select a specific day and time to work each week, while others drop in when their schedule allows.

TIME COMMITMENT: Flexible. Work as few, or as many, hours as you would like. The store is open 6 days a week from 10am-3pm .

FOOD PANTRY

Food Pantry volunteers stock shelves and prepare bags of food for delivery and/or partner with another volunteer to deliver food to individuals in need in our local area.

TIME COMMITMENT: 1-2 hours per session

PICK UP PERSON

(Meat, Bread, Furniture)

Volunteer to pick-up items when your schedule allows.

Meat – is picked up on Monday morning and is delivered to the Food Pantry.

Bread – is picked up Saturday and Sunday morning's and is delivered to the Food Pantry.

Furniture – is picked up one Saturday a month, with a team of men.

TIME COMMITMENT: 1-4 hours per pick-up

HELP LINE

Help line workers are the first point of contact. They check incoming messages, voice & e-mail, making initial assessment before individuals are assigned a Caseworker. Internet access and basic computer skills are required.

TIME COMMITMENT: 1-2 hours a day for on call period.
